

<u>Code of Behaviour & Ethics for Parents, Guardians</u> and Officials

- 1. Remember that skaters participate in sport for their enjoyment, not yours.
- 2. Encourage skaters to participate and have fun, do not force them.
- 3. Focus on the skater's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
- 4. Encourage skaters to always participate according to the rules and to settle disagreements without resorting to hostility or violence.
- 5. Never ridicule or yell at a skater for making a mistake.
- 6. Remember that we all learn best by example. Appreciate good performances and skilful participation by all participants.
- 7. Do not physically or verbally abuse or harass anyone associated with the sport.
- 8. Be a positive role model.
- 9. Ensure you are aware of and follow the correct processes if you have an issue or complaint do not perpetuate issues with gossip or general criticism.
- 10. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- 11. Respect coaches, judges and the Ice Synchro committee and/or WAISA decisions and guide skaters to do likewise.
- 12. Show appreciation for volunteer officials and administrators. Without them skaters could not participate. All contributions are valued equally.
- 13. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every skater regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- 14. Preserve and protect the reputation and standing of the sport and ISWA.
- 15. Understand the possible consequences of breaching the above items according to the Member Protection Policy and Codes of Behaviour.
